Immunostaining


Detect tissue/cellular distribution of protein

QuickTime™ and a TIFF (Uncompressed) decompressor are needed to see this picture.

Procedure

- Tissue fixation
 - Transcardial perfusion
 - Paraformaldehyde in PBS

Wear protective(eye glass/glove)



Tissue sectioning

- Freezing Microtome
 - Cut fixed tissue to 40-50 μm
 - Freeze tissue before and while sectioning

Polyclonal Antibody

- Antigen purified protein/partial peptide
- Inject to various animals (other than mouse)

Lab level: rabbit

Commercial production: sheep, goat, horse

Check titer by western or ELIZA

Monoclonal Antibody

Monoclonal (mouse)

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Detection methods

- Requires high spatial resolution
 - HRP and DAB
 - Gold particle (electron microscopy)
 - Fluorescence (multiple labeling)

– Chemiluminescence is not appropriate. Why?

Fluorescence detection

- Anti-GFAP (rabbit) < anti-rabbit IgG (goat)fluorescein (green)
- Anti-NeuN (mouse) <anti-mouse IgG (goat)-Texas-Red (red)

This does not work- why?

- Anti-GFAP (goat) < anti-goat IgG (horse)fluorescein (green)
- Anti-NeuN (mouse) <anti-mouse IgG (goat)-Texas-Red (red)

This also does not work- why?

- Anti-GFAP (goat) < anti-goat IgG (horse)fluorescein (green)
- Anti-NeuN (mouse) <anti-mouse IgG (<u>sheep</u>)-Texas-Red (red)
