Strategies for questions

- Talk within your knowledge
- Buying time
- Thinking out loud

Buying time

- Ask the question back.
- Ask that the question be repeated.
- Repeat the question yourself.
- Just wait.

Thinking out loud

- Be clear this is what you're doing.
- Pause a lot.
- Determine a path before you start.
- Say why you're unsure of steps.

Asking Questions

- Be humble and polite.
- Look at a single slide or pause to consider a single point.
- If you don't understand probably others don't either.
- Be prepared, read ahead of time!
