Gender as Performance

- **Judith Butler:**

- Gender is a "stylized repetition of acts...which are internally discontinuous [so that] the appearance of substance is precisely that, a constructed identity, a performative accomplishment which the mundane social audience, including the actors themselves, come to believe to perform in the mode of belief."
