#### PRIMITIVE BLOCK DIAGRAM OF SPEECH PRODUCTION MODEL

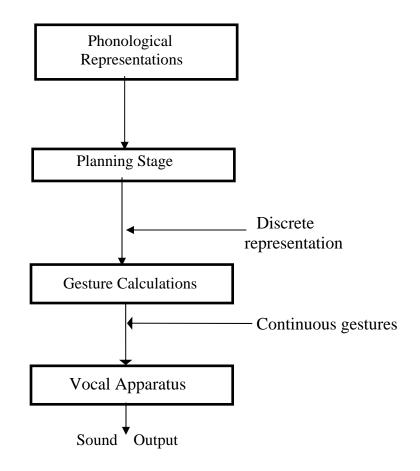


Figure 2. A Planning Stage is added to the basic components in Figure 1.

### ADDING ENHANCEMENT GESTURES

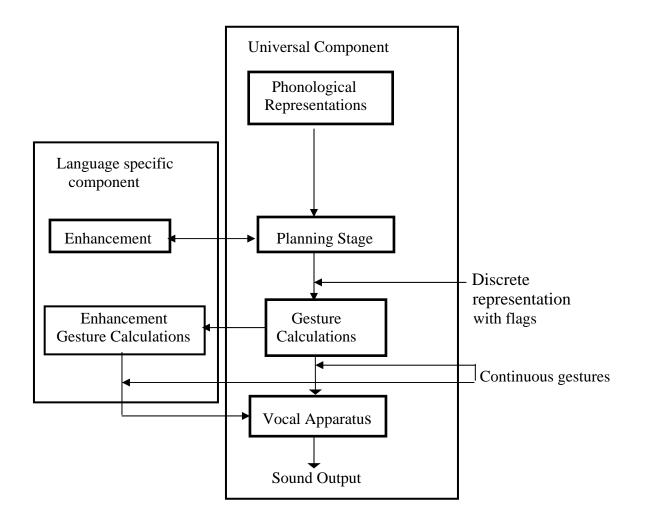


Figure 4. Enhancement and enhancement gesture calculations are added to Figure 2. The Enhancement component augments Planning Stage representations by flagging relevant features. Enhancement gestures are calculated for these flagged features.

# ADDING OVERLAP COMPONENT

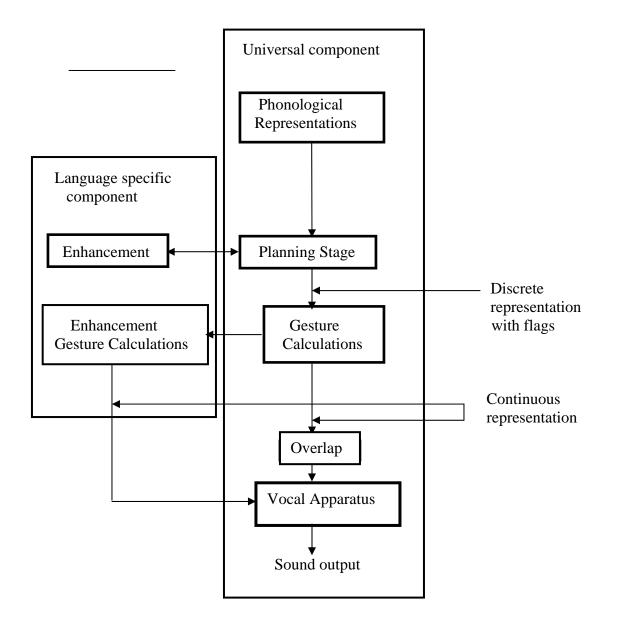


Figure 8. Figure 7 is modified to indicate that enhancement gestures are not subject to overlap.
