- The article provided few details—what would be the advantages/disadvantages of providing more detail? If you were to include more detail, what would you include?

Notice how the article "First Improvement of Fundamental Algorithm in 10 Years" communicates the "essence" of the maxflow problem. Keeping in mind the questions above, write a brief and rough draft of how you would communicate the "essence" of the following topic in an MIT News article:

- Generating functions (if you have been assigned to Problem 1 for your term paper),
- Union bound (Problem 2),
- The maxflow-mincut theorem (Problem 3)
