- 2. Why does (or might) it matter that these initiatives are anchored in communitybased economic institutions, i.e. labor unions, a worker cooperative network? And how do they define the roles of the nonprofit and public sector organizations?
- 3. Appraisal: How, if at all, do these models seem to address the challenges and opportunities identified by **Siegel and Seidman** in their paper?
